CONSENT ORDER

The Department of Financial and Professional Regulation of the State of Illinois, Division of Professional Regulation by Vladimir Lozovskiy, one of its attorneys, and Michel Y. Roy, D.C., Applicant, hereby agree to the following:

STIPULATIONS

The Applicant has made application for issuance of a Chiropractic Physician License in the State of Illinois.

The Department is in receipt of information that Applicant was disciplined by the Quebec Order of Chiropractors for advertisement violations as well as patient care issues. See Exhibit A attached hereto and made a part of this Consent Order. (Quebec Order of Chiropractors, Case No. 08-03-00211). The allegations set, if proven to be true, would constitute grounds for suspending, revoking and other discipline of Respondent's license on authority of 225 ILCS 60/22(A)(12).

At all times material to the matter set forth in this Consent Order, the Department of Financial and Professional Regulation of the State of Illinois had jurisdiction over the subject matter and parties herein.

On October 14, 2009, Applicant appeared in person in front the Illinois Medical Licensing Board and provided evidence and supporting testimony regarding his prior

discipline by Quebec Order of Chiropractors. In addition, Applicant provided information about his clinical practice as well as his future plans.

Applicant has been advised of the right to a hearing, the right to contest denial of his application for license, and the right to administrative review of any Order resulting from a hearing. Applicant knowingly waives each of these rights, as well as any right to administrative review of this Consent Order.

In order to resolve this matter amicably, Applicant and the Department have agreed that Michel Y. Roy, D.C., be permitted to enter into a Consent Order with the Department, providing for the imposition of measures which are fair and equitable in the circumstances and which are consistent with the best interest of the people of the State of Illinois.


CONDITIONS

WHEREFORE, the Department, through Vladimir Lozovskiy, its attorney, and Applicant, Michel Y. Roy, D.C., agree:

- A. Michel Y. Roy's Illinois Chiropractic Physician License shall be issued with the Reprimand;
- B. This Consent Order shall become effective immediately after it is approved by the Director of the Division of Professional Regulation.
