FINAL ORDER OF STATUTORY REVOCATION

As noted below, the Texas Board of Chiropractic Examiners (Board) has received notice that Abbas Zahedi D.C., License No. 10717, (Respondent) has been convicted of a felony criminal offense. The Texas Chiropractic Act, Texas Occupations Code §201.5065 (b) mandates that the Board revoke a chiropractor's license on proof that the chiropractor has been convicted of a felony.

Finding of Fact:

1. Respondent is a chiropractor licensed by the Board to practice chiropractic in Texas.
2. The respondent's license was in full force and effect at all times and dates material and relevant to this Final Order.
3. On or about June 24, 2014, a judgment of guilty was entered against Respondent in a case styled THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA VS. ABBAS ZAHEDI, D.C., Criminal Case No. 4:14-CR-087-O, the UNITED STATES DISTRICT COURT, NORTHERN DISTRICT OF TEXAS, FT. WORTH DIVISION. Please see Exhibit "A".
4. On or about August 20, 2014, the Enforcement Committee of the Board considered this matter and recommended that the Board execute this statutory revocation because Respondent had been convicted of a felony.


5. The Board considered this matter at its meeting on August 21, 2014 and voted to revoke the Respondent's license.

Conclusions of Law:

1. At all times pertinent to this action, Respondent was subject to all laws and rules administered by the Board.
2. The Texas Chiropractic Act, Texas Occupations Code §201.5065 (b) states "On final conviction for an offense described by subsection (a), the Board shall revoke the chiropractor's license."
3. Offenses described in subsection (a) include (1) "(A) a felony."
4. Because Respondent has been convicted of a felony, the Board is required under §201.5065 (b) to revoke Respondent's license.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Texas Board of Chiropractic Examiners that the license held by Respondent Abbas Zahedi, D.C., License No. 10717, is revoked, effective the date of this order. If enforcement of this order is restrained or enjoined by an order of a court, this order shall then become effective upon a final determination by said court or appellate court in favor of the Texas Board of Chiropractic Examiners.

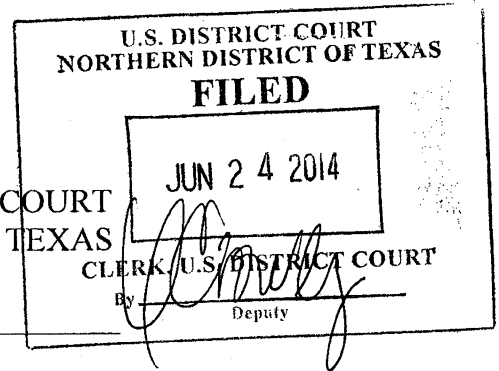
