STATEMENT  
OF  
CHARGES

Respondent

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The State Board for Professional Medical Conduct, upon information and belief, charges and alleges as follows:

I. EMANUEL REVICI, M.D., Respondent, was authorized to engage in the practice of medicine in the State of New York on February 6, 1947 by the issuance of license number 045718 by the State Education Department.

II. Respondent is currently registered with the New York Education Department to practice medicine for the period January 1, 1983 through December 31, 1985, at 164 East 91st Street, New York, New York 10028.

III. Respondent is charged with professional misconduct within the meaning of N.Y. Educ. Law §6509 (McKinney Supp. 1983) as set forth in the following specifications:

FIRST SPECIFICATION

IV. Respondent is charged with practicing the profession fraudulently within the meaning of N.Y. Educ. Law §6509(2) [McKinney Supp. 1983] in that:

1. Patient A, having a previous diagnosis of cancer, was caused by Respondent to believe that he could cure her cancer and entered upon a course of treatment which Respondent knew would not cure such cancer, and, when Patient A discussed seeking other treatment at a hospital, Respondent attempted to dissuade her.
  
2. Patient B, having a previous diagnosis of cancer, was caused by Respondent to believe that he could cure her cancer and entered upon a course of treatment which Respondent knew would not cure such cancer, and when Patient B sought other treatment at a hospital, Respondent attempted to dissuade her.

3. Patient C, after a previous diagnosis of cancer, was caused by Respondent to believe that he could cure her cancer and entered upon a course of treatment which Respondent knew would not cure such cancer, and even though Respondent claimed that the cancer was cured, Patient C subsequently died as a result of cancer.

#### SECOND SPECIFICATION

V. Further, Respondent is charged with practicing the profession with gross incompetence within the meaning of N.Y. Educ. Law §6509(2) [McKinney Supp. 1983], and the allegations set forth in the First Specification, paragraph IV, numbers 1 through 3, regarding Patient A, Patient B, and Patient C, are hereby repeated, restated and realleged as if fully set forth herein, except that Respondent should have known that the treatment would not cure cancer.

#### THIRD SPECIFICATION

VI. Further, Respondent is charged with practicing the profession with gross negligence on a particular occasion within the meaning of N.Y. Educ. Law §6509(2) [McKinney Supp. 1983], and the allegations set forth in the First Specification, paragraph IV, numbers 1 through 3, regarding Patient A, Patient B, and Patient, are hereby repeated, restated and realleged as

if fully set forth herein, except that Respondent should have known that the treatment would not cure cancer.

#### FOURTH AND FIFTH SPECIFICATIONS


VII. Further, Respondent is charged with practicing the profession with negligence or incompetence on more than one occasion within the meaning of N.Y. Educ. Law §6509(2) [McKinney Supp. 1983], and the allegations set forth in the First Specification, paragraph IV, numbers 1 through 3, regarding Patient A, Patient B, and Patient C, are hereby repeated, restated and realleged as if fully set forth herein, except that Respondent should have known that the treatment would not cure cancer.

#### SIXTH SPECIFICATION

VIII. Further, Respondent is charged with violating 8 NYCRR 29.2(a)(3) in failing to maintain a record for each patient which accurately reflects the evaluation and treatment of the patient, and the allegations set forth in the First

Specification, paragraph IV, numbers 1 through 3, regarding Patient A, Patient B and Patient C, are hereby repeated, restated and realleged as if fully set forth herein.
