NOTICE OF CHARGES AND
ALLEGATIONS

You are hereby given notice that the Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina has preferred and does hereby prefer against you the following charges and allegations:

That at various times in 1983 and 1984 in Wake County, North Carolina and at other localities in North Carolina and South Carolina you prescribed the use of ethylenediaminetetraacetic acid (EDTA) for various patients and you treated various patients with EDTA for the alleged treatment and alleviation of vascular ailments, including arteriosclerosis and atherosclerosis, and for such prescribing and treating you were paid money.

The above allegations, if proven, would constitute grounds, pursuant to N.C.G.S. §§90-14(a)(6), (8) and (12), for the suspension or revocation of the license to practice medicine issued to you by the undersigned Board.

You are further given notice that you will be given an opportunity to appear before the Board in person and by counsel in a hearing concerning the foregoing charges and allegations on the 15th day of March, 1985 at 1:00 o'clock, P.M. at the North Raleigh Hilton, Old Wake Forest Road, Raleigh, North Carolina at

which time you may present evidence in your behalf. In the meantime, you may file, within thirty (30) days, a written response to the foregoing charges if you so desire.
