THE GRAND JURY CHARGES:

COUNT ONE

1. On or about the 13th day of August, 1980, in the Northern District of Georgia, ALMON GLENN BRASWELL, the defendant herein, while under oath as a witness before a Grand Jury of the United States of America, duly empaneled and sworn in the United States District Court for the Northern District of Georgia, did then and there knowingly make false material declarations.

2. At the time and place aforesaid, the Grand Jury was engaged in an investigation into the activities of one Salvatore Boriello, said activities concerning suspected extortion, mail fraud, wire fraud and income tax evasion by Mr. Borriello.

3. It was material to that investigation to determine the extent of defendant ALMON GLENN BRASWELL's business relationship with Mr. Borriello, specifically the reasons for and extent of monetary transactions between defendant ALMON GLENN BRASWELL and Mr. Borriello.

4. At the time and place stated in paragraph 1, defendant, ALMON GLENN BRASWELL appeared as a witness before the said Grand Jury, and then and there being under oath did knowingly make false and material declarations as follows:

[false declaration is underlined]

Q "Did you ever hear of a company called National Nutrition?"

A No.

Q That doesn't - -

A There's so many companies like that that they all sound the same."

Whereas, as defendant, ALMON GLENN BRASWELL, then and there well knew, the underlined answer above was false in that in April, 1978, National Nutrition Federation, Inc., known as National Nutrition, was incorporated for the purpose of marketing a hair growing product known as "Hair Start," which in fact was supplied by and identical to defendant ALMON GLENN BRASWELL's own product "Head Start," which was marketed by his company Cosvetics Laboratories, Inc.; in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1623.

COUNT TWO

1. Paragraphs 1, 2, and 3 of Count 1 of this Indictment are hereby realleged and incorporated herein by reference as though each allegation were set forth herein.

2. At the time and place as aforesaid in paragraph one, defendant, ALMON GLENN BRASWELL appeared as a witness before the said Grand Jury, and then and there being under oath did knowingly make a false and material declaration as follows:


Q "Did you, other than the deal for tv time, did Mr. Borriello furnish you with any other service or products or did you have any other business transactions with him?"


A No."


Whereas, as defendant, ALMON GLENN BRASWELL then and there well knew, his answer was false in that Mr. Borriello had, during 1978, in addition to other relationships with defendant ALMON GLENN BRASWELL, acted on behalf of defendant ALMON GLENN BRASWELL and his company Braswell, Inc., and its subsidiaries, including but not limited to Cosvetics Laboratories, Inc., in negotiating reductions in monies owed certain national magazines by defendant ALMON GLENN BRASWELL and his aforementioned companies, as a result of advertising done by those publications on behalf of defendant ALMON

GLENN BRASWELL and his aforementioned companies, in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1623.
