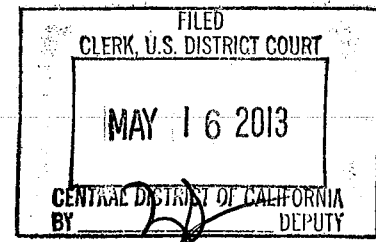

21 On September 26, 2011, Defendant CHRISTINE DANIEL was found
 22 guilty of violations that generated proceeds of at least
 23 \$1,277,083.00. The United States has filed an Application for
 24 Entry of a Money Judgment of Forfeiture against the Defendant in
 25 the amount of \$1,277,083.00 pursuant to Federal Rule of Criminal
 26 Procedure 32.2. Rule 32.2(c)(1) provides that "no ancillary
 27 proceeding is required to the extent that the forfeiture consists
 28 of a money judgment."

1 GOOD CAUSE APPEARING THEREFOR, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED,
2 ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Defendant shall forfeit to the
3 United States the sum of \$1,277,083.00 pursuant to Title 18,
4 United States Code, Section 981, and Title 28, United States
5 Code, Section 2461(c).

6 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the United States District Court
7 shall retain jurisdiction in the case for the purpose of
8 enforcing this Order.

9 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that pursuant to Rule 32.2(b) ⁴ ~~(2)~~ ^{RST}, this
10 Order of Forfeiture shall become final as to the Defendant at the
11 time of sentencing, and shall be made part of the sentence and
12 included in the judgment.

13 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the United States may, at any
14 time, move pursuant to Rule 32.2(e) to amend this Order of


4 *Notwithstanding the foregoing, this judgment will be*
